

Q: What is the California Rock Camp?

A: The California Rock Camp (CRC) provides adult rock fans living outside California to come to Hollywood to experience their rock dreams in a four day / three night session of jams, one-on-one lessons, band clinics and live recording in world class studios with top tier pros.

Q: How Many Campers attend per session?

A: To insure the ideal environment to learn, each CRC session is limited to only 10 campers maximum. (other "camps" get crowded and impersonal with well over 50 attendees)

Q: What is the typical profile for a camper to attend CRC ?

A: Adult age 30-50 range who is a fan of rock-n-roll with an intermediate skill level to play either guitar, drums, keyboards or sing vocals. Sorry, we do not have a program for teens or beginners at this time.

Q: What is included in the CRC Package ?

A: Tailored specifically for intermediate-level players with a Rock & Roll passion and a desire to learn from and jam with world class pro faculty, the CRC 2009 inclusive "J package# 2" for Japan clients provides the roundtrip airfare from Narita to LAX, upscale resort hotel, local limo transportation, all instruction, materials and equipment needed to learn, jam and record.

Q: Are instruments provided ?

A: Campers are welcome to bring their own favorite instrument with them, or they can use the available back line equipment in the studios including guitars, basses, drums and keyboards.

Q: What happens once Registered?

A: Once registered for the chosen CRC session, each camper receives, in advance, a Camper Kit which includes 1) The Essential Song List & Practice CD 2) CRC T-Shirt 3) Signed copy of "Led Zeppelin Crashed Here" (book about famous rock-n-roll historical stories and spots in USA) 4) additional schedule details, learning materials and contact points.

Q: What happens upon arrival in Los Angeles ?

A: Upon Thursday afternoon arrival, CRC registered campers will be given a studio tour and then fitted for instruments. The guitar, bass, drums, keyboard and vocal workshops and rehearsals at night are focused on learning the CRC Essential Song List which contains a collection of famous and legendary classic rock tunes from the 60s, 70s & 80s. Open Camper Jams will happen for three nights in one of the four rehearsal rooms. The Live Band Tracking Sessions will be held in the afternoon and evening of Saturday, with the final sessions wrap-up with final mix-downs and mastering of the take home Session CD on Sunday.
